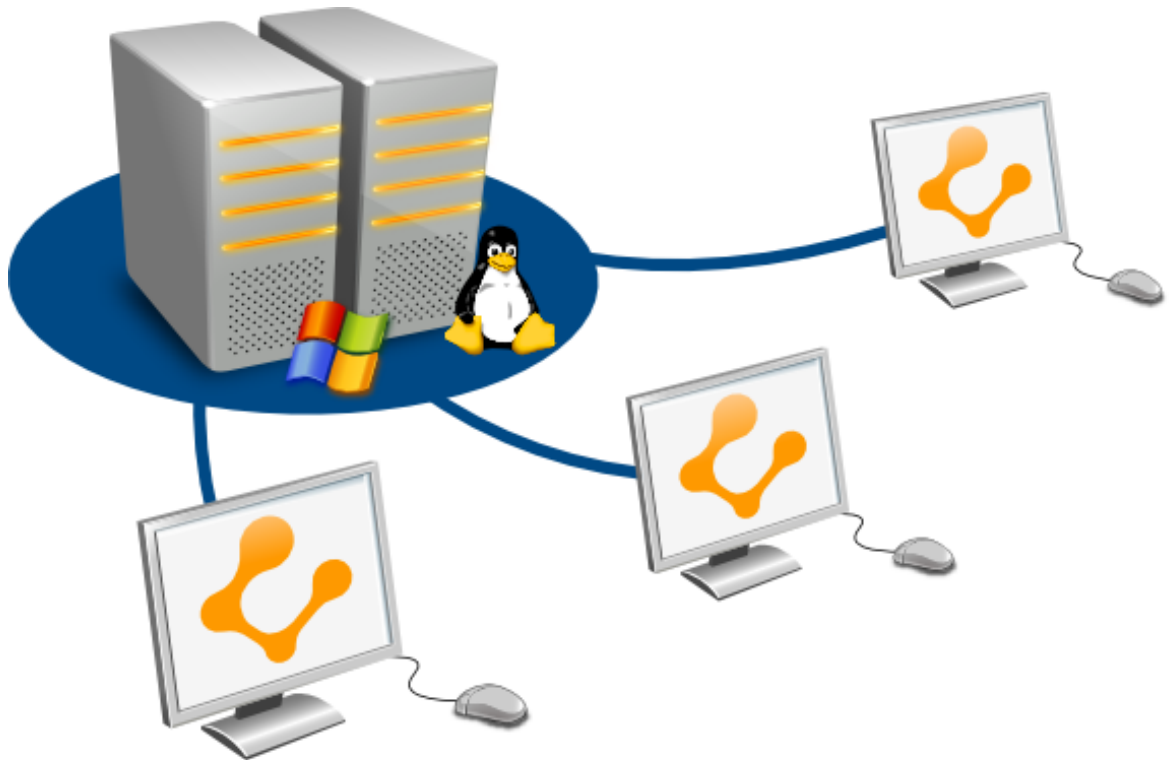

This documentation aims to provide a way to upgrade an existing Ulteo OVD architecture from minor version.

IMPORTANT



This documentation doesn't provide a way to upgrade major version of Ulteo OVD (for instance, **from 1.0 to 2.0**).

1 Session Manager

NOTE

Those operations have to be done on the Session Manager.

1.1 Using Debian or Ubuntu packages (standard installation)

- Update the package list:

```
# apt-get update
```

- Upgrade the system:

```
# apt-get upgrade
```

1.2 Using Red Hat packages

- Order an upgrade:

```
# yum update
```

2 Application Server

NOTE

Those operations have to be done on each Application Server of your architecture.

2.1 Core System

2.1.1 Using Debian packages (standard installation)

- Update the package list:

```
# apt-get update
```

- Upgrade the system:

```
# apt-get upgrade
```

2.1.2 Using Red Hat packages

- Order an upgrade:

```
# yum update
```

2.2 Application System

From the Session Manager administration console, go to the Server page, select *manage* and click on *Upgrade the internal system and applications*.
